ROSTER OF PHYSICS DEPARTMENTS WITH ENROLLMENTS AND DEGREE DATA, 1996.

This roster contains detailed data from the annual Survey of Enrollments and Degrees. The survey was conducted during the 1996-97 academic year and consists of all degree-granting physics departments in the United States. Presented in this roster are the data for the 1995-96 introductory enrollments, 1995-96 degrees and the 1996-97 undergraduate and graduate student enrollments.

The introductory enrollment figures represent the number of students who were taking their first college/university physics course. The undergraduate enrollments only include students at the junior and senior level. Data on total graduate student enrollment, as well as the number of foreign and first year students included in that total, are given for departments that offer graduate degrees.

Data are not presented for departments who did not contribute to the study. Some departments only supplied partial data and consequently have an incomplete entry.

Notations used in this roster:

m Department grants a masters as its highest physics degree (N=77).

p Department grants a PhD as its highest physics degree (N=184).

GRADUATE DEPT ONLY Department has no undergraduate program in physics (N=8).

MASTERS This column includes both masters degrees from masters-granting departments and masters degrees from doctorate departments whose students are leaving that department.

MASTERS ENROUTE This column contains masters degrees from doctorate-granting departments for students continuing onto their PhD in the same department.

— Data for this field were not provided.

The totals presented in the following table represent all physics departments. This includes data from the responding departments as well as estimated data for the non-responding departments. All estimates were derived from department responses to the survey in a previous year.
