## Scholarship during the War

THE HUMANITIES AND THE SCIENCES IN DENMARK DURING THE SECOND WORLD WAR, a collection of papers. Ejnar Munksgaard. 723 pp. Copenhagen, 1948. 60.00 (Danish Crowns).

This volume is, as the publishers have clearly indicated in the preface, a review of the work accomplished by scholars in both the humanities and the sciences in Denmark during the period of occupation. Of particular interest are those chapters devoted to the researches carried out during this period in mathematics, theoretical physics, nuclear physics, biological physics, and chemical physics. These chapters have been prepared respectively by the following authors, W. Feuchel and B. Jessen; Niels Arley, J. K. Bøggild, Tage Larsen and Børge Bak.

The chapters throughout the book are extremely condensed, in few cases containing even what may be regarded as an abstract of the work done. In spite of the briefness of the accounts the book is a work of 723 pages. Each chapter does, however, contain a very complete bibliography of the works reviewed and in this respect represents a valuable contribution.


