havior; computer scientists in unrelated fields claimed to have proved that the ABM couldn't work, and physicists claim to show that nuclear explosions can have no peaceful use. When scientists forget their duty to pursue truth wherever the search leads, when they start selecting facts to support comforting world-views or the policies of the good guys, they lose much of their value to society.


