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From work on the big bang that helped end a war to understanding the Big Bang, that brilliant band in Los Alamos helped to write the science of both the immediate future and the remote past.

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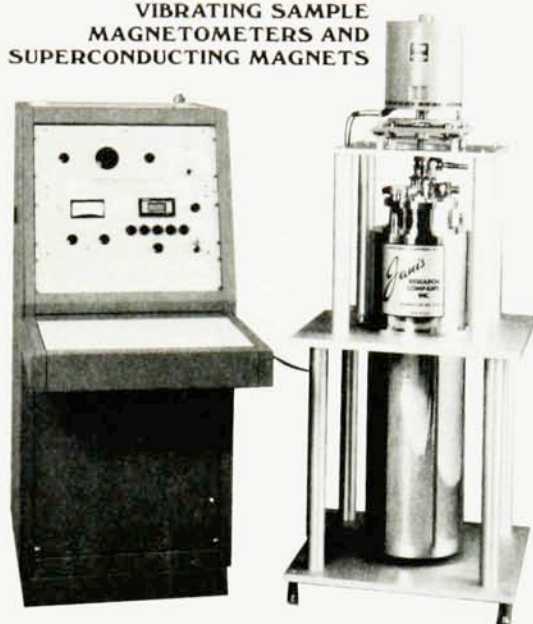
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
