

and mesoscale plasma processes, this monograph may be more useful than most to researchers in other fields. For example, one new and novel algorithm for the numerical simulation of hot, collisionless plasmas is presented by David Nunn of the University of Southampton. This efficient, low-noise and simple algorithm is very general and is applicable to many plasma systems in which collisions can be neglected.

Any edited collection of this type can suffer from a lack of focus when covering such a complex, multidisciplinary field. This monograph would have benefitted by inclusion of a unifying paper to bring all the threads together, yet the tapestry has unity, and a careful reading is well rewarded.

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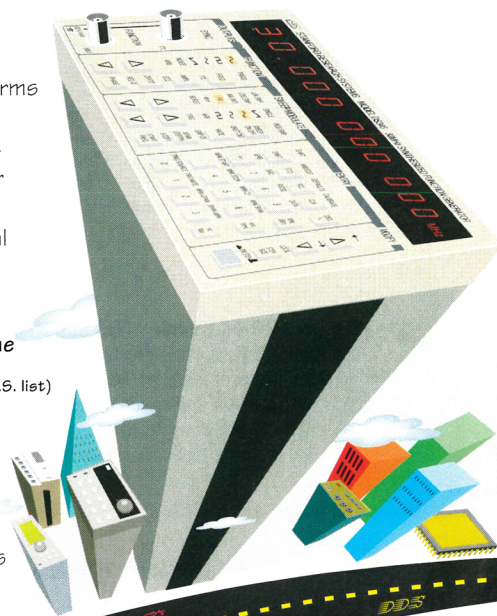
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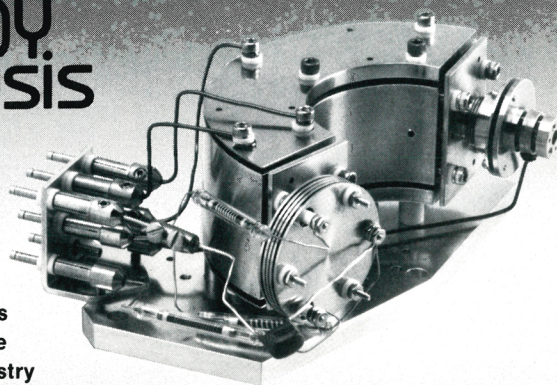
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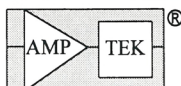
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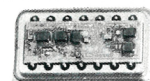
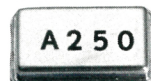
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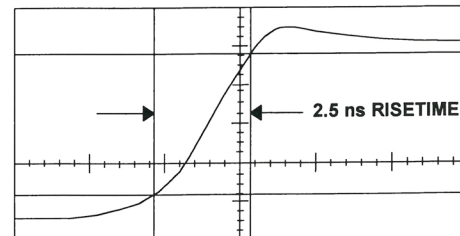
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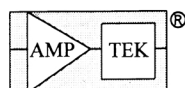
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
