ROSTER OF PHYSICS DEPARTMENTS WITH ENROLLMENT AND DEGREE DATA, 1998.

This roster contains detailed data from the annual Survey of Enrollments and Degrees. The survey was conducted during the 1998-99 academic year and consists of all degree-granting physics departments in the United States. Presented in this roster are the data reported by those departments for the 1997-98 introductory course enrollments, 1997-98 degrees and the fall 1998 undergraduate and graduate student enrollments.

The figures representing undergraduate majors consist of students at the junior and senior level. Data on total graduate student enrollment, as well as the number of foreign and first year students included in that total, are given for departments that offer graduate degrees.

Of the 762 degree-granting physics departments, 713 contributed to the data supplied in this year's roster. Data are not presented for departments who did not contribute to the study. Some departments only supplied partial data and consequently have an incomplete entry.

Notations used in this roster:

- m Department grants a masters as its highest physics degree (N=72).
- ρ Department grants a PhD as its highest physics degree (N=183).
- GRADUATE DEPT ONLY Department has no undergraduate program in physics (N=9).
- MASTERS** This column includes masters degrees from both masters-granting and doctoral-granting departments whose students are leaving that department with a masters.
- MASTERS ENROUTE** This column contains masters degrees from doctorate-granting departments for students continuing onto their PhD in the **same** department.
- Data for this field were not provided.

The totals presented in the table below represent all physics departments. This includes data from the responding departments as well as estimated data for the non-responding departments. Some data had to be estimated for departments who reported only partial information. These estimates were derived from a department's response to the survey in a previous year.
